#### Category 2:

A: If you had to choose a fictional character from TV, film or literature, that is most like you, who would you choose and why do they reflect who you are?

B: How do you feel about the way that Black women are portrayed in the media?

#### **Category 3:**

A: If you had to be any of these objects, which would you like to be and why: A clock, a pair of shoes or a duck?

B: If you lived in a world that was in black and white, what one thing would you make color and why?

Please carefully read and respond to the following prompt in 250-500 words. Write your essay on a separate document or sheet of paper and submit it along with the application. Make sure to clearly write your full name, school and date of birth at the top of every page.
